On the evening of March 5, Kathryn Hinsch led the UEA's two first of 2019 Map Your Neighborhood/Emergency Response trainings. UEA also performed two trainings in 2018. The training walks participants through a simple nine-step process that allows them to customize an emergency preparedness plan and identify potentially lifesaving resources available in neighborhood.
